### **Jackie Beede Appointed Judge for 2013 Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award**

Jackie Beede of Ox Bodies, Inc/TBEI, Inc., located in Fayette, Alabama has been appointed by Dr. Patrick Gallagher, Director of the U.S. Commerce Department's National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), to the 2013 Board of Examiners as a Judge for the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award. The Award, created by public law in 1987, is the highest level of national recognition for performance excellence that a U.S. organization can receive.

As an examiner, Jackie is responsible for reviewing and evaluating applications submitted for the Baldrige Award. The board is composed of approximately 500 leading experts selected from industry, professional and trade organizations, education and health care organizations, and nonprofits (including government). Only 12 examiners are selected as Judge to serve for three years.

Those selected meet the highest standards of qualification and peer recognition. All members of the board must take part in a preparation course based on the Baldrige Criteria for Performance Excellence and the scoring and evaluation processes for the Baldrige Award.

The Baldrige Award may be given annually in each of six categories: manufacturing, service, small business, education, health care, and nonprofit. Awards have been presented to 93 organizations, including the 2012 recipients: Lockheed Martin Missiles and Fire Control, Grand Prairie, Texas (manufacturing); MESA Products Inc., Tulsa, Okla. (small business); North Mississippi Health Services, Tupelo, Miss. (health care); and City of Irving, Irving, Texas (nonprofit).
